

WITCHES OF EASTWICK COSTUME NOTES

MENS chorus to provide:

1. Single breasted dinner jacket/suit
(Let us know urgently if you still don't have one)
2. (All except 5 waiters) Trousers eg chinos as part of bowling outfit, you will be given tops to wear.
3. Trousers/shirt/tank top, jumper OR single breasted suit as normal day wear.

LADIES chorus to provide:

1. Those who are dancers in 'Dance with the Devil' and the five townswomen (Sheila, Liz, Jacqui, Kerry, Josie) need a black and red outfit. Kevin/Sue have spoken to you about these
2. Other chorus costumes are to be provided except ladies wearing skirts or pedal pushers (other than dresses or twinsets) who will need a plain T-shirt. You will get these costumes on Weds 23rd which should give you time to match up a top but, if in doubt, or you want to organise before then, happy for some to be white. Also, to accentuate the difference between the daytime scene (beginning) and the evening (concert), a good number of traditional, button-up cardigans are needed for the daywear for all ladies.
3. You will need to provide accessories to dress up the day wear for the concert and the wedding. Jewellery, wraps/stoles, gloves etc. should be added for these scenes.

ACCESSORIES

Please look at the books/pictures available at rehearsal for the look of men's and women's accessories, (1950s), and for hair style. Some ladies with pedal pushers/skirts may want to wear plimsolls and 'bobby' socks
